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Background

- Digital transformation is significantly increasing according to DESI, all states are improving their digital performance
- COVID-19 crisis further accelerates a rapid digitalisation at the workplaces

High number of different collective labour agreements (800+ in Italy alone!)

Agreements are outdated (often created before 90s)

Agreements do not correspond to the new digital realities



Growing management difficulties among companies, especially SMEs

Declining efficiency

Difficulties to compete

Worsened quality of the employment

- analyse the impact and the opportunities of digitalisation on companies and their employees
- examine how the trends brought by digitalisation are reflected in the collective labour agreements across Europe
- consider two major areas: smart working & development of digital skills in the work-places
